II. DEFINITION

Singular is When a noun means one only

Example : Book, table and Girl

Plural is when a noun means more than one

Example : Books, tables, and Girls.

Rule

The plural of nouns is usually formed by adding -s to a singular noun.

Example : Lamp lamps

Cat Cats

Nouns ending in **s**, **z**, **x**, **sh**, and **ch** form the plural by adding **-es**

Example : Dress Dresses

Wish Wishes

Nouns ending **-y** form the plural by adding **-ies**

Example : Lady Ladies

 City Cities

Nouns ending **O** form the plural by adding **-es**

Example : Hero Heroes

 Tomato Tomatoes

There are singular nouns that is same as the Plurar nouns

Example : Deer Deer

 Sheep Sheep
